African American Museum

3536 Grand Ave, Dallas, TX 75210
Showcases African American art, history, and culture, with one of the largest folk art collections in the nation.

Crow Museum of Asian Art

2010 Flora St, Dallas, TX 75201
Showcases art and artifacts from across Asia, with exhibitions ranging from ancient to contemporary.

Dallas Holocaust & Human Rights Museum

300 N Houston St, Dallas, TX 75202
Offers powerful exhibits on the Holocaust and the ongoing struggle for human rights.

Dallas Museum of Art

1717 N Harwood St, Dallas, TX 75201
One of the largest art museums in the U.S., featuring works from around the world.

George W. Bush Presidential Library & Museum

2943 SMU Boulevard, Dallas, TX 75205
Presents artifacts and exhibits from the presidency of George W. Bush, including a replica Oval Office.

Meadows Museum

5900 Bishop Blvd, Dallas, TX 75205
Located at Southern Methodist University, it houses one of the most comprehensive collections of Spanish art outside of Spain.

Museum of Illusions

Museum with interactive optical art & sets for photos with visual illusions, plus a gift shop.

National Cowgirl Museum & Hall of Fame

Proudly honoring women from diverse backgrounds, cultures, and ethnicities, whose courage and independence helped shape the West.

Nasher Sculpture Center

2001 Flora St, Dallas, TX 75201
Features a renowned collection of modern and contemporary sculpture.

Perot Museum of Nature and Science

2201 N Field St, Dallas, TX 75201
An interactive museum with exhibits on dinosaurs, space, gems, and more.

The Sixth Floor Museum at Dealey Plaza

411 Elm St, Dallas, TX 75202
Located within the former Texas School Book Depository building, this museum chronicles the assassination and legacy of President John F. Kennedy.

The Ann & Gabriel Barbier-Mueller Museum: The Samurai Collection

2501 N Harwood St, Suite 225, Dallas, TX 75201
Displays an extensive array of samurai armor and artifacts, highlighting Japanese history and craftsmanship.

Amon Carter Museum of American Art

3501 Camp Bowie Blvd, Fort Worth, TX 76107
Features collections by leading artists working in the United States and its North American territories in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries.

Fort Worth Aviation Museum

3300 Ross Ave, Fort Worth, TX 76106
Dedicated to preserving and promoting the history of aviation in Fort Worth, the North Texas region, and around the world.

Fort Worth Museum of Science & History

1600 Gendy St, Fort Worth, TX 76107
Dynamic educational hub that engages the community through interactive exhibits and programs focused on science and regional history.

Kimbell Art Museum

3333 Camp Bowie Blvd, Fort Worth, TX 76107
Renowned Asian & European-focused collection plus exhibits set in a Louis Kahn-designed building.

Log Cabin Village

2100 Log Cabin Village Ln, Fort Worth, TX 76109
Costumed actors & a collection of historic buildings illustrate life in mid-19th-century Texas.

Modern Art Museum of Fort Worth

3200 Darnell St, Fort Worth, TX 76107
Features post-World War II art in a striking building designed by architect Tadao Ando.

Sid Richardson Museum

309 Main St, Fort Worth, TX 76102
Focuses on Western art, particularly works by Frederic Remington and Charles M. Russell.

Stockyards Museum

131 E Exchange Ave, Fort Worth, TX 76164
Artifacts & photos in a landmark building illustrate the history of Ft. Worth's livestock industry.

Vintage Flying Museum

505 NW 38th St # 33S, Fort Worth, TX 76106
The Vintage Flying Museum is a unique "working" museum where visitors see what it takes to "Keep 'em Flying"

Grapevine Museums & Galleries

206 W Hudgins St, Grapevine, TX 76051
Includes the Grapevine Historical Museum and other cultural attractions that showcase the area's rich history.

Heritage Farmstead Museum (Plano)

1900 W 15th St, Plano, TX 75075
A preserved 1891 Victorian farmstead that offers insights into North Texas's agrarian past.

Museum of the American Railroad (Frisco)

8004 Dallas Pkwy #400, Frisco, TX 75034
Exhibiting more than 70 pieces of steam, diesel, passenger, and freight railroad equipment sitting on 15 acres making it one of the largest historic rail collections in the US.

Rockwall County Historical Foundation Museum (Rockwall)

901 E Washington St, Rockwall, TX 75087
Located in Harry Myers Park, this museum complex exhibits historical objects & memorabilia detailing the county's history.

Wise County Heritage Museum (Decatur)

119 N State St, Decatur, TX 76234
Local history museum with a collection of artifacts and military uniforms, plus genealogy information.
